

SAVANNAH RIVER SITE TOUR ACCEPTABLE ID LIST

All visitors to the Savannah River Site must provide **two forms** of identification to receive a Visitor's Badge granting access to the site.

- One must be a valid photo identification document from **List A** below.
- The second can be from either List A or List B.

All visitors will also be required to provide their Social Security Number on the day of the tour.

1. U.S. Passport (unexpired or expired)	1. Voter's registration card
2. Driver's license or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color and address	2. U.S. Military card or draft record
	3. Military dependent's ID card
	4. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
3. ID card issued by federal, state or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color and address	5. Native American tribal document
	6. U.S. Social Security card, issued by the Social Security Administration
4. School ID card with a photograph (NOTE: participants must be 18 years of age or older to take the SRS tour.)	7. Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority or outlying possess of the United States bearing an official seal
5. DOE issued Savanna River Site Badge. (Note all SRS employees are REQUIRED to bring their badge the day of their schedule tour.)	8. U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
